

Special Town Meeting Warrant

Town Meeting of Frenchboro

To: Rebecca Lenfestey, in the Town of Frenchboro, in the County of Hancock, State of Maine

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of Frenchboro, in the said County, qualified by the law to vote in town affairs, to meet in said town at the Municipal Building, on the day of August 26, 2013, at six o'clock in the evening to act on the following articles, to wit:

Articles to Elect Town Officials

Article 1 To choose one moderator to preside at said meeting.

Written ballot required

Article 2 To choose one Select Board Member/Assessor/Overseer of the Poor for the remainder of the term expiring at the next Annual Town Meeting. Rebecca Lenfestey is resigning.

Written ballot required

Articles to Appropriate Funds

Article 3 To see if the voters of the Town of Frenchboro will vote to appropriate and expend \$7,285.71 for completion of the Town Wharf project.

Explanation: \$7,285.71 was the amount remaining in the Town Wharf operational account on June 30, 2013. This money had been raised previously by the Town and through taxes, donations and grants. This article re-appropriates this amount for the purpose for which it was originally raised and received, and permits the Select Board to pay the final invoice on the project when received.

Select Board recommends passage.

Article 4 To see what additional sum the Select Board is authorized to expend for **Administrative Salaries** for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, and to see what sum the Town will vote to raise and appropriate for the same.

Select Board recommends: \$500.00

Explanation: The administrative salaries appropriated at the annual Town Meeting did not include any amount for a Code Enforcement Officer. State law requires the Town to have a Code Enforcement Officer, and the Select Board has found a qualified person willing to accept the position.

Article to Enact an Ordinance

Article 5 Shall an ordinance entitled "Frenchboro Town Dock, Float, and Harbor Ordinance" be enacted?

Note: Copies of the text of the ordinance are available from the Town Clerk.

The Select Board gives notice that they and Registrar of Voters will be in session at 5:30 pm on said day for the purpose of receiving and correcting the list of voters.


